Qualifications for Membership

The two qualifications for membership are (1) to be Noongar, and (2) to be at least 18 years of age. All members, including current members, must nominate a Ward to which they have a traditional connection. While it's possible that some may have a traditional connection to more than one Ward, for the purposes of SWALSC membership, members can only nominate one of the six listed Traditional Wards.

When nominating a Traditional Ward, applicants need to demonstrate that they are descended from ancestors, the original traditional owners, in that country by completing the form over the page. Upon acceptance as a member you will be eligible to participate in elections in your nominated Ward.
