selection training course – what's in it for me?

This unique 5-week program will prepare you for the selection process used by the Commonwealth Bank. It covers

- Communication
- Teamwork
- Customer service
- Banking-specific skills such as cash handling and use of banking terminology

The program will improve your overall Employability Skills even if you decide you don't want to work in banking at the end of it. You may also be able to gain Skills Recognition against units within an Australian Qualification.

There are 15 places on the course – and at least 10 jobs available in the Commonwealth Bank in Western Australia for Aboriginal people with the skills and aptitude to develop a career in this demanding professional sector.

eligibility:

You must be over 18 years of age and an eligible Jobseeker with a Jobseeker ID. This program has been specifically developed for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Australians only.

fees:

There are no fees for this course.

course dates and venue:

The course starts in April 2011 and runs for 5 weeks. It will be held at Central Institute of Technology's Leederville campus and at the Commonwealth Bank Training Centre in the City.

We are holding interview and enrolment sessions on 27th and 28th January 2011 in room 1161 of the Leederville campus (corner of Richmond and Oxford Streets, Leederville), if you want to come along.
